An itinerary in the Vall d'Ordino to help you discover the landscape, culture and history of all the villages in the valley.

A total of 15 km of natural and easy paths takes you to twenty-four points of tourist interest, with audio-guides at each point so that you can relive the histories of these villages and unite the past, present and future of an area that has been declared a Biosphere Reserve by Unesco. It is a project designed for the enjoyment of nature with all five senses, including texts in Braille and sign language.
